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HOUSE AMENDMENT "*A*" to H.P. 1151, L.D. 1633, Bill, "An Act To Prohibit the Disposal of Dangerous and Unsafe Material in Solid Waste Facilities"

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Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§1316-P.~~" in the first paragraph in the first line (page 1, line 44 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Class E crime" and inserting in its place the following: 'civil violation for which a fine of not more than \$500 may be assessed'

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This amendment changes the penalty for concealing or disposing dangerous or unsafe material from a Class E crime to a civil violation.
