This amendment establishes that operation of the Unused Pharmaceutical Disposal Program is contingent upon adequate funding received by the Pharmaceutical Disposal Program Fund. Currently, the fund is not projected to receive any significant revenue and absent resources from that source, the program will not be operational during the 2006-07 biennium. It is estimated that the annual costs to operate the program will be approximately \$220,000.
