Sec. 1. Salmon and brook trout habitat restoration. Resolved: That the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall coordinate and facilitate salmon and brook trout habitat restoration efforts. The department shall conduct a statewide survey to create a priority list for habitat restoration for salmon and brook trout. The department shall facilitate the creation of a database that contains a wide variety of habitat information that may be used for subsequent analyses of salmon distribution, population and habitats.
