2 **SUMMARY** 4 The bill, as amended by Committee Amendment "A," exempts from the county assessment limit the specific county jail costs of medical costs for inmates and costs for boarding prisoners in 6 jails outside the county for fiscal year 2005-06 in Sagadahoc County and fiscal year 2006-07 in all other counties. This amendment requires that, although those costs are not considered 8 10 when setting the county assessment limit, those costs must be considered as expenses of the State when calculating the State's 12 General Fund appropriation limitation.
