Further amend the amendment in paragraph D in the last line (page 1, line 32 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "6 and 7" the following: 'but instead is limited to an increase over the prior fiscal year's expenditures for these items equal to the average annual percentage increase in expenditures for these items in that county in the previous 3 years'

8 Further amend the amendment by inserting after paragraph D the following:

'Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the 12 summary the following:

'Sec. 3. County officials to use Department of Corrections services.
 County officials responsible for administering county jails shall
 use available services provided by the Department of Corrections to minimize the costs of operating county jails.

**Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the 20 preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.' '

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#### **SUMMARY**

This amendment provides that, for fiscal year 2005-06 in 26 Sagadahoc County and fiscal year 2006 in all other counties, that portion of the county assessment that is necessary to fund jail costs for medical treatment of inmates and boarding prisoners in 28 jails outside the county is limited to an increase over the prior 30 fiscal year's expenditures for these items equal to the average annual percentage increase in expenditures for these items in that county in the previous 3 years. The amendment requires 32 county officials responsible for administering county jails to use available services provided by the Department of Corrections 34 to minimize the costs of operating county jails and adds an 36 emergency preamble and an emergency clause.
