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'Sec. 17. Review of legislative proposals. During January 2006 the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human Services shall review the legislative proposals contained in Legislative Document 1673 from the 122nd Legislature that were not enacted during 2005. The committee is authorized to report out a bill to the Second Regular Session of the 122nd Legislature regarding the proposals and the report of the Commission to Study Maine's Community Hospitals.'

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Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

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## SUMMARY

This amendment is a minority report of the committee. The amendment amends the provisions regarding the use of a standardized accounting template for information reporting by hospitals and requires review in 2006 of the proposals in the bill that were not enacted by the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over health and human services matters. The amendment also deletes from the bill the provisions related to the Hospital Cooperation Act of 1992, the certificate of need hearing process and review of certificate of need program staffing in the Department of Health and Human Services.
