Resolve, Authorizing the President of the Maine Community College System To Sell 1.37 Acres of Real Property Owned by Southern Maine Community College in South Portland

2	Sec. 1. Definitions. Resolved: That, as used in this resolve,
2	unless the context otherwise indicates, the following terms have the following meanings.

6	1. "Board of trustees" means the Board of Trustees of the Maine Community College System.
8	2. "President" means the President of the Maine Community College System.

12	3. "Property" means the real estate described in section 3 of this resolve with any buildings and improvements, together
14	with all appurtenant rights and easements, and all personal property located on that property, if any; and be it further
16	Sec. 2. Authority to convey property. Resolved: That the
18	president, pursuant to a duly authorized vote of the board of trustees, is authorized to:
20	1. Convey by sale the interests of the Maine Community College System in the property;
22	corredt biboom in one propercy,
	2. Negotiate, draft, execute and deliver any documents
24	necessary to settle any boundary line discrepancies;
26	3. Exercise the power of eminent domain to quiet for all time any possible challenges to ownership of the property;

	4. Negotiate, draft, execute and deliver any easements or
30	other rights that, in the president's discretion, may contribute to the value of the proposed sale; and

	Sec. 3. Property interests authorized to be conveyed. Resolved:
38	That the property authorized to be sold or leased is the
40	following:
40	An unimproved parcel of land consisting of 1.37 acres, more
42	or less, near, but not adjacent to, remaining property of
	Southern Maine Community College, in South Portland, Maine.
44	Title to said parcel, designated Lots 124 and 125 on the
	City of South Portland Assessor's Map 005, was formerly held
46	by the State of Maine but was transferred to the Maine Community College System in 2002; and be it further

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	Sec. 4. Property to be sold as is. Resolved: That the property
2	must be sold "as is," with no representations or warranties.
4	Title must be transferred by quitclaim deed without covenant and executed by the president; and be it further
6	Sec. 5. Exemptions. Resolved: That a conveyance pursuant to
8	this resolve is exempt from any statutory or regulatory requirement that the property first be offered to the Maine State
10	Housing Authority or another state or local agency; and be it further
12	Sec. 6. Appraisal. Resolved: That the president shall have
14	the current market value of the property determined by an independent appraiser. The property may be listed for sale with
16	a private real estate broker at its appraised value or auctioned or sold directly to a purchaser. The president may negotiate the
18	terms of sale including the purchase price. The president may reject any offers.
20	If the president elects to solicit bids, notices of sale
22	must be advertised; and be it further
24	Sec. 7. Proceeds. Resolved: That any proceeds from sales pursuant to this resolve must be deposited in an account to be
26	designated by the president and used to purchase all or a portion of a parcel abutting Southern Maine Community College, said
28	property to be used for parking or other uses in support of Southern Maine Community College's mission; and be it further
30	
32	Sec. 8. Sunset provision. Resolved: That this resolve is repealed 3 years from its effective date.
34	SUMMARY
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-	This resolve authorizes the President of the Maine Community
38	College System to sell a 1.37-acre, more or less, parcel of unimproved land owned by Southern Maine Community College in
40	South Portland, provided that the proceeds of the sale are used to purchase land adjacent to the Southern Maine Community College
42	campus for parking or other purposes of the college.
