8 SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 648, L.D. 1694, Bill, "An Act To Allow the
9 Towns of Mapleton, Castle Hill and Chapman To Deposit All Tax Revenues, Grant
10 Revenues and Other Income and Revenues into One Depository Account"

11 Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the
12 following:

13 'Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts of the Legislature do not become effective
14 until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

15 Whereas, this legislation authorizes the towns of Mapleton, Castle Hill and
16 Chapman to create and maintain a common ownership depository account in the name of
17 the 3 towns; and

18 Whereas, this arrangement will allow the towns to realize considerable cost savings
19 and increased administrative efficiencies; and

20 Whereas, it is imperative that legislation take effect as soon as possible in order to
21 maximize these savings and efficiencies; and

22 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within
23 the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as
24 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
25 therefore,'

26 Further amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

27 'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes
28 effect when approved.'

30 This amendment adds an emergency preamble and clause to the bill.
