11 12	Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following:
13 14	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
15 16 17	Whereas, this legislation authorizes the towns of Mapleton, Castle Hill and Chapman to create and maintain a common ownership depository account in the name of the 3 towns; and
18 19	Whereas, this arrangement will allow the towns to realize considerable cost savings and increased administrative efficiencies; and
20 21	Whereas, it is imperative that legislation take effect as soon as possible in order to maximize these savings and efficiencies; and
22 23 24 25	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'
26	Further amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:
27 28	'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.'
