COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "**A**" to S.P. 650, L.D. 1696, Bill, "An Act To Clarify the Assessment of Costs To Maintain a Private Way or Bridge"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "**§3103.**" in the indented paragraph in the 5th and 6th lines (page 1, lines 12 and 13 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "their interests, who as indicated by their assessed valuation for property tax." and inserting in its place the following: 'their interests,--who each owner's interest. An owner's interest is based on the assessed valuation for property tax on the owner's parcel that is benefited by the private way or bridge.'

SUMMARY

The bill provides that the assessment for the repair or maintenance of a private way or bridge is applied proportionally on the owners according to their assessed valuation for property tax. The amendment clarifies that the assessed valuation for property tax is on each owner's parcel that is benefited by the private way or bridge.
