calendar year is eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of the monthly premium for supplemental life insurance offered by the Federal Government from the Commissioner of Defense, Veterans and Emergency Management in an amount up to \$16.25 per month for each month in 2006 that member serves in either theater of operations and for which that member purchases supplemental life insurance.

- Sec. 2. Reimbursement by commissioner. From the effective date of this section until June 30, 2007, the Commissioner of Defense, Veterans and Emergency Management shall reimburse a member of the National Guard or the Reserves of the United States Armed Forces for the cost of the monthly premium for supplemental life insurance offered by the Federal Government in an amount up to \$16.25 per month for each month in 2006 in which the member served in the theater of operations for Operation Enduring Freedom or Operation Iraqi Freedom regardless of the length of time served during any given month. The commissioner shall verify, based on proof provided by the member of the National Guard or the Reserves of the United States Armed Forces assigned to a unit located in the State, that supplemental life insurance was purchased.
- Sec. 3. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill. It requires that the Commissioner of Defense, Veterans and Emergency Management reimburse members of the National Guard and Reserves assigned to a unit in Maine for the cost of monthly premiums paid to the Federal Government for supplemental life insurance. A member of the National Guard or Reserves assigned to a unit in Maine who serves in the theater of operations for Operation Enduring
