2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §2181, sub-§7,** as amended by PL 2005, c. 222, §2, is further amended to read:

6 **7. Staff assistance.** The Executive Department, State
7 Planning Office shall provide or arrange all necessary staffing
8 and support services for the advisory commission. The State
9 Planning Office may contract with appropriate entities to provide
10 staffing and support services. The State Planning Office shall
11 designate an individual as the intergovernmental coordinator.
12 The purpose of the coordinator is to encourage improved
13 governmental cooperation, efficiencies in service delivery and
14 coordination of regional and cooperative efforts initiated
15 through state departments and agencies.

16 **Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations.** The following
17 appropriations and allocations are made.

22 **State Planning Office**

24 Initiative: Provides funds for administrative and research staff
