2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §10704** is enacted to read:

6 **§10704. Hunting while carrying intoxicating liquor**

8 **1. Prohibition.** A person may not hunt wild animals or wild
birds while carrying intoxicating liquor.

10 **2. Penalty.** A person who violates this section commits a
12 civil violation for which a fine of \$200 must be adjudged.

14 **SUMMARY**

16 This bill prohibits a person from hunting wild animals or
wild birds while carrying intoxicating liquor.
