HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1235, L.D. 1727, Bill, "An Act To Extend the Lobbyist Reporting Requirements to Executive Branch Lobbying Activities"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 9 by inserting at the end the following: ' "Lobbying" does not include time spent by any person providing information to or participating in a subcommittee, stakeholder group, task force or other work group regarding a legislative action by the appointment or at the request of the Governor, a Legislator or legislative committee, a constitutional officer, a state agency commissioner or the chair of a state board or commission as long as the person's regular employment does not otherwise include lobbying.'

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that "lobbying" does not include time spent by any person providing information to or participating in a subcommittee, stakeholder group, task force or other work group regarding a legislative action by the appointment or at the request of the Governor, a Legislator or legislative committee, a constitutional officer, a state agency commissioner or the chair of a state board or commission as long as the person's regular employment does not otherwise include lobbying.

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
