
SENATE AMENDMENT **A** to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1236,
L.D. 1728, "Resolve, Directing the Cumberland County Commissioners To Establish a
Task Force To Establish New County Commissioner Districts"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 2 in amendment) by
striking out the following: "submit the 2 plans under section 1" and inserting in its place
the following: 'vote on which plan of the 2 under section 1 to send to the voters and
submit the plan'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in the 3rd line (page 2, line 3 in
amendment) by striking out the following: "receiving the higher number of votes"

SUMMARY

This amendment amends the committee amendment to require the apportionment
commission to choose one of the plans produced by the commission that is to be sent to
the voters.
