1 **Sec. 1. Task force; established. Resolved:** That the Cumberland County
2 Commissioners shall establish a task force to establish 7 county commissioner districts
3 and shall submit a report based on its findings, including necessary implementing
4 legislation, to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over
5 state and local government matters no later than December 1, 2007. The joint standing
6 committee may submit a bill based on the report to the First Regular Session of the 123rd
7 Legislature.

SUMMARY

9 This resolve directs the Cumberland County Commissioners to put together a task
10 force to establish 7 county commissioner districts and to submit its report no later than
11 December 1, 2007 to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction
12 over state and local government matters.
