registration pursuant to this subsection shall maintain the amounts of motor vehicle financial responsibility specified in section 1605.

Sec. 3. 29-A MRSA §513, sub-§2, ¶C, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 6 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:

8 C. For Class B special meter mobile equipment, if the gross weight is in excess of 20,000 pounds, the registrant must
10 obtain a permit as required by section 2382, subsection 5.'

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the minority report of the Joint 16 Standing Committee on Transportation, replaces the bill. Currently, all special mobile equipment used on public ways must be registered in this State. The amendment clarifies that 18 special mobile equipment that is rented from a location in Maine or outside Maine must be registered in Maine, regardless of the 20 location of the main office or headquarters of the owner of the 22 equipment. The amendment provides that special mobile equipment that is carried by a towing vehicle to a construction project and 24 then used on a public way only to construct or repair that public way is exempt from registration. However, the exempt equipment must be operated only within the boundaries of a closed way. 26 In addition, the owner of special mobile equipment that is exempt 28 from registration must maintain motor vehicle financial responsibility. The amendment also makes a technical correction to the section on special mobile equipment. 30
