2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §504, sub-§6** is enacted to read:

6 6. Rental commercial motor vehicle. An owner of a
8 commercial motor vehicle used for rental purposes primarily in
10 this State must register that vehicle according to this section
12 if the vehicle is used and payment is made for the rental in this
14 State and the vehicle is rented for construction or road
16 maintenance use, regardless of where the owner of that rental
vehicle has the owner's business main office or headquarters.

SUMMARY

This bill requires the registration in Maine of all construction and road maintenance vehicles being rented in Maine for operation on public ways.
