Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §661, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, 4 Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:

Application. If a certificate of title or certificate 6 1. of salvage is lost, stolen, mutilated or destroyed or becomes 8 illegible, the owner or legal representative of the owner named in the certificate, as shown by the records of the Secretary of 10 State, shall promptly make application for and may obtain a duplicate upon furnishing information satisfactory to the 12 Secretary of State. A duplicate certificate of title or certificate of salvage must-contain-the-legend,--"This-is-a duplicate -- certificate - and - may -- be -- subject -- te-- the -- rights -- of -- a 14 person-under-the-original-certificate-"--It must be mailed to the owner named on the certificate unless that owner gives written 16 authorization to mail the certificate to another person. If a certificate of lien has been lost, stolen, mutilated or destroyed 18 or becomes illegible, the first lienholder shown on the 20 certificate may apply for and obtain a duplicate upon furnishing information satisfactory to the Secretary of State. 22

SUMMARY

26 This bill eliminates the requirement that a duplicate certificate of title or certificate of salvage contain language 28 indicating that the certificate is a duplicate.
