COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 691, L.D. 1774, Bill, "An Act To
10 Improve the Water Quality and Safety of Phillips Lake"

Amend the bill by striking out section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'P&SL 2005, c. 17 is repealed.'

SUMMARY

14

This amendment is the minority report. The amendment repeals the requirement that
15 the dam at the outlet at the north end of Phillips Lake in the Town of Dedham be
16 constructed, operated and maintained at no higher than 227 feet above sea level and at a
17 width that is no less than the current width of the dam.
