SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 706, L.D. 1789, Bill, "An Act To Deter Environmental Terrorism in the State"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 1 by striking out all of paragraph F (page 2, lines 18 to 24 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'F. Intentionally damages, destroys or tampers with the property of another, having no reasonable ground to believe that the person has a right to do so, for the purpose of harming substantially any other person with respect to that person's health, safety, business, calling, career, financial condition, reputation or personal relationships.'

SUMMARY

The amendment specifies that a person commits aggravated criminal mischief if the person intentionally damages, destroys or tampers with the property of another, having no reasonable ground to believe that the person has a right to do so, for the purpose of harming substantially any other person with respect to that person's health, safety, business, calling, career, financial condition, reputation or personal relationships.
