2	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 4	Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §1197, sub-§4, ¶B, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 710, §2, is amended to read:
6	B. A self-employment assistance allowance is payable to an
8	individual at the same interval, on the same terms and subject to the same conditions as regular benefits except that:

12	(1) The requirements of section 1192, subsection 3 relating to availability for work and active search for work are not applicable to the individual;

16	(2) The requirements of section 1193, subsection 3 relating to refusal to accept work are not applicable to the individual;
18	(2) The mentioner of marking 1101 when the 2 and
20	(3) The requirements of section 1191, subsection 3 and section 1043, subsection 17 relating to self-employment income are not applicable to the individual;

24	(4) An individual is considered unemployed for the purposes of section 1192; and
26	(5) An individual who fails to participate in self-employment assistance activities or who fails to
28	actively engage on a full-time basis in activities, which may include training, related to establishing a
30	business and becoming self-employed is denied benefits for the week the failure occurs; and

34	(6) The self-employment assistance allowance may not be reduced by per diem compensation paid to an individual for work related to establishing a business
36	<u>and performance of self-employment assistance</u> <u>activities.</u>

42	This bill amends the Maine Enterprise Option program to
	allow an individual to receive per diem compensation for work
44	related to establishing a business and performance of self-employment assistance activities without experiencing a
46	reduction in the self-employment assistance allowance.
