COMMITTEE AMENDMENT *A* to H.P. 1253, L.D. 1813, Bill, "An Act To Allow Smelt Dipping in Long Lake in Aroostook County"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

**'An Act To Allow Smelt Dipping in Mud Brook in Aroostook County'**

Further amend the bill in section 1 in §12460-A in the first line (page 1, line 5 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Long Lake" and inserting in its place the following: 'Mud Brook'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in §12460-A by striking out all of the first indented paragraph (page 1, lines 7 to 10 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'Notwithstanding section 12456, a person may fish for smelt by use of a dip net in Mud Brook, a tributary of Long Lake within Township 17, Range 3, Aroostook County. A person may not:'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in §12460-A by inserting after subsection 2 the following:

'3. Repeal. This section is repealed January 1, 2008.'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment is the majority report and limits fishing for smelt with a dip net to a tributary of Long Lake called Mud Brook. The amendment also provides a repeal date of January 1, 2008.
