2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §3252, sub-§4-B** is enacted to read:

6 **4-B. Targeted funds; other students.** In addition to
8 tuition rates calculated pursuant to chapter 219, targeted funds
10 for each student must be paid to the school administrative unit
12 or private school approved for tuition purposes that a student
attends. For purposes of this subsection, "targeted funds" means
those funds identified under essential programs and services for
technology, assessment and kindergarten to grade 2 pursuant to
section 15671, subsection 6 and section 15681.

14 **Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §3253-A, sub-§3-B** is enacted to read:

16 **3-B. Targeted funds; other students.** In addition to
18 tuition rates calculated pursuant to chapter 219, targeted funds
20 for each student must be paid to the school administrative unit
22 or private school approved for tuition purposes that a student
attends. For purposes of this subsection, "targeted funds" means
those funds identified under essential programs and services for
technology and assessment pursuant to section 15671, subsection 6
and section 15681.

28 This bill provides that targeted funds be paid to the school
30 administrative unit or private school that each student attends
in addition to tuition rates calculated pursuant to the Maine
Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, chapter 219.
