2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1359** is enacted to read:

6 **§1359. Application; exception**

8 This subchapter does not apply to a line worker training
10 program provided by the Maine Community College System or to an
12 instructor or an institution insofar as that instructor or
14 institution is providing a line worker training program through
16 the Maine Community College System.

14 **SUMMARY**

16 This bill specifies that the laws governing driver education
18 courses do not apply to line worker training programs provided by
the Maine Community College System.
