One trustee may be a municipal officer of the Town of St. Francis. A trustee who is also a municipal officer shall abstain from any vote of municipal officers on a question relating to compensation of the trustees pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 35-A, section 6410, subsection 7.

23 24 25 26 27	This amendment replaces the bill. It amends the charter of the St. Francis Water District to allow one member of the water district board of trustees to be a municipal officer of the Town of St. Francis. The amendment requires a trustee who is also a municipal officer to abstain from voting on the compensation of trustees. The amendment also corrects the name of the town in the bill title.
