9 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1273, L.D. 1833, Bill, "An Act To
10 Change the Charter of the Saint Francis Water District"

11 Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

12 **'An Act To Change the Charter of the St. Francis Water District'**

13 Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before
14 the summary and inserting in its place the following:

15 **'Sec. 1. P&SL 1989, c. 51, §8, first sentence** is amended to read:

16 All the affairs of the district ~~shall be~~ are managed by an elected board of trustees
17 composed of 3 ~~members of the~~ legal voters of the district. One trustee may be a
18 municipal officer of the Town of St. Francis. A trustee who is also a municipal officer
19 shall abstain from any vote of municipal officers on a question relating to compensation
20 of the trustees pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 35-A, section 6410,
21 subsection 7.'

22 **SUMMARY**

23 This amendment replaces the bill. It amends the charter of the St. Francis Water
24 District to allow one member of the water district board of trustees to be a municipal
25 officer of the Town of St. Francis. The amendment requires a trustee who is also a
26 municipal officer to abstain from voting on the compensation of trustees. The
27 amendment also corrects the name of the town in the bill title.
