2 The joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over natural resources matters is authorized to 4 report out legislation relating to the department's report pursuant to this resolve to the First Regular Session of the 6 123rd Legislature.'

#### SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill and makes it a resolve. 12 The amendment directs the Department of Environmental Protection to report on the effectiveness of current cellular telephone 14 recycling collection programs in the State. The amendment authorizes the joint standing committee of the Legislature having 16 jurisdiction over natural resources matters to report out legislation to the First Regular Session of the 123rd Legislature.
