9 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1286, L.D. 1846, Bill, "An Act To 10 Streamline Criteria for Municipal General Assistance for Heating and Utility Assistance 11 "

12 Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

13 'Resolve, Directing the Department of Health and Human Services To
14 Establish a Working Group To Examine Ways for Municipalities To

Distribute More Heating Assistance'

15 Distribute More freating Assistance

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the title and inserting in its place the following:

18 'Sec. 1. Department of Health and Human Services to establish a 19 working group to examine ways for municipalities to distribute more heating assistance. Resolved: That the Department of Health and Human Services shall 20 establish a working group to examine ways for municipalities to provide additional 21 22 heating assistance for low-income individuals, including through the municipal general 23 assistance program, particularly during periods of unmet need under the federal Low 24 Income Heating Assistance Program. For the purposes of the study, "low-income individuals" means persons eligible for the federal Low Income Heating Assistance 25 Program. The working group must include representatives from each of the agencies and 26 27 organizations on the general assistance committee established in Resolve 2003, chapter 28 116 as well as at least one representative from the Maine State Housing Authority and at 29 least one representative from community action programs. The working group may also 30 include any other persons or representatives of organizations determined appropriate by 31 the department; and be it further

32 Sec. 2. Report and recommendations. Resolved: That the Department of 33 Health and Human Services shall report its findings under section 1 and 34 recommendations, including suggested legislation if appropriate, to the joint standing 35 committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over state and local government matters 36 no later than December 15, 2006; and be it further

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1 Sec. 3. Authority to report out legislation. Resolved: That the joint standing 2 committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over state and local government matters 3 is authorized to report out legislation concerning the study under section 1 to the First 4 Regular Session of the 123rd Legislature.'

SUMMARY

6 This resolve replaces the bill. It directs the Department of Health and Human 7 Services to establish a working group to examine ways for municipalities to distribute 8 more heating assistance to residents who are eligible for the federal Low Income Heating 9 Assistance Program. The department shall submit its findings and recommendations, 10 including suggested legislation, to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having 11 jurisdiction over state and local government matters by December 15, 2006.
