HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1306, L.D. 1866, Bill, "An Act To Amend the Motor Vehicle Laws"

Amend the bill by inserting before section 1 the following:

'Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §101, sub-§46-A is enacted to read:

46-A. Nonimmigrant. "Nonimmigrant" means a person who is not a citizen or lawful permanent resident of the United States.'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 2 the following:

'Sec. 3. 29-A MRSA §1301, sub-§11 is enacted to read:

11. Nonimmigrant applicants. An applicant for a license who is a nonimmigrant must present to the Secretary of State at each application written proof, evidence or documentation that the applicant's presence in the United States is authorized under federal law.

Sec. 4. 29-A MRSA §1401, sub-§9 is enacted to read:

9. Nonimmigrant applicants. An applicant for a license who is a nonimmigrant must present to the Secretary of State at each application written proof, evidence or documentation that the applicant's presence in the United States is authorized under federal law.'


