30	<u>§8011. Cost-share fund established; purpose</u>
32	A forest certification incentive cost-share fund, referred to in this chapter as "the fund," is established as a nonlapsing dedicated account to provide incentives to licensed foresters and
34	landowners for obtaining independent 3rd-party certification and
36	recertification. The bureau shall administer the fund in accordance with section 8014. The bureau may accept donations
38	and grants from public and private sources for deposit in the fund.'
40	Further amend the bill in section 3 in subsection 3 in
42	paragraph B in the 2nd line (page 2, line 5 in L.D.) by striking out the following: " <u>must receive no</u> " and inserting in its place the following: ' <u>may not receive any</u> '

Administration of cost-share fund; procedure 8 The bureau shall administer the fund to reimburse eligible persons for a portion of the costs of obtaining independent 3rd-party certification in accordance with this section. 10 1. Eligibility. The following persons are eligible for 12 cost-share funds: 14 A. A licensed forester who has obtained independent 3rd-party certification or recertification as a forest 16 resource manager in order that the forester's client landowners may obtain the benefits accruing from such 18 certification; 20 B. A landowner who owns 1,000 acres or less of forest land 22 statewide and has obtained independent 3rd-party certification or recertification for the land; and 24 C. A group of landowners who have collectively obtained 3rd-party certification or recertification for their land as 26 long as some or all of the landowners own 1,000 acres or 28 less. 2. Maximum amount of cost-share funds distributed. The 30 amount of cost-share funds distributed to a person eligible for reimbursement under subsection 1, paragraph A or B may not exceed 32 50% of the cost of obtaining independent 3rd-party certification. 34 The maximum amount of cost-share funds distributed to a group of 36 landowners eligible for reimbursement under subsection 1, paragraph C is calculated by multiplying the number of landowners 38 in the group who own 1,000 acres or less of forest land by 50% of the cost of obtaining independent 3rd-party certification and 40 dividing the product by the total number of landowners in the group. 42 For the purposes of this subsection, "cost of obtaining independent 3rd-party certification" means the fee paid to an 44 external auditor to complete the certification process. 46 3. Repayment required. A licensed forester, landowner or group of landowners that accepts cost-share funds in accordance 48 with this chapter but that fails to retain certification for the

full certification period shall repay the full amount of the 2 cost-share funds received to the bureau. The bureau may impose a reasonable interest rate on the amount of the funds to be repaid. The bureau shall deposit all repayments and interest 4 received under this subsection into the fund. 6 4. Forms. The bureau shall provide application forms for 8 licensed foresters, landowners and groups of landowners seeking cost-share funds pursuant to this chapter.' 10 12 **SUMMARY** 14 This amendment is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry. It expands 16 the eligibility criteria for reimbursement from the forest certification incentive cost-share fund to include a group of 18 landowners who collectively receive certification. It also allows the fund to be used for recertification. It limits the 20 amount of reimbursement received by a group of landowners based on the number of landowners at or below the 1,000-acre ownership 22 threshold.
