24 Act To Amend Certain Laws Administered by the Department of

28 Amend the bill by inserting after section 8 the following:

30 'Sec. 9. 38 MRSA §1665-A, sub-§5, ¶B, as amended by PL 2005,
32 c. 148, §5, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

34 B. Pay for each mercury switch brought to the consolidation
36 facilities as partial compensation for the removal, storage
38 and transport of the switches:

40 (1) A minimum of \$4 if the vehicle identification
42 number of the source vehicle is provided; and

44 (2) A minimum of \$3 if the vehicle identification
46 number of the source vehicle is not provided;'

48 Further amend the bill by inserting after section 9 the
following:

'Sec. 10. PL 2005, c. 452, Pt. C, §5 is amended to read:

42 **Sec. C-5. Report.** The work group established under section 2
44 of this Part shall provide updates or reports to the council as
46 determined by the council. The council shall submit its final
report and recommendations to the joint standing committee of the
Legislature having jurisdiction over natural resources matters no
later than November 1, 2007 2006.'

4 consecutively.

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8 **SUMMARY**

10 This amendment corrects the date by which the Land and Water
Resources Council must submit its final report regarding the
study of state regulation of groundwater withdrawal. The
12 amendment also clarifies the amount of payment required by
automobile manufacturers for mercury switches brought to
14 consolidation facilities.
