The Legislature retains final authority to make policy decisions on the subject matter of this resolve based on any joint standing recommendations of the committee jurisdiction over Legislature having utilities and energy matters; and be it further

Sec. 2. Reports. Resolved: That the Public Utilities Commission shall issue an interim report on the status of its inquiry pursuant to section 1 and any preliminary findings and recommendations to the joint standing committee Legislature having jurisdiction over utilities and energy matters by January 1, 2007. The joint standing committee may request additional interim reports from the commission as the joint standing committee determines appropriate. The commission shall issue a final report of its findings and recommendations to the joint standing committee by January 1, 2008.

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The joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over utilities and energy matters may report out legislation on the subject matter of this resolve to the First Regular Session or the Second Regular Session of the 123rd Legislature; and be it further

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Sec. 3. Appropriations and allocations. Resolved: That the following appropriations and allocations are made.

The joint standing committee is authorized to request additional interim reports from the commission as the committee determines appropriate. The commission is directed to issue a final report of its findings and recommendations to the Joint Standing Committee on Utilities and Energy by January 1, 2008. The amendment also adds an appropriations and allocations section to the bill.
