**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

**Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §15915, sub-§1, ¶C**, as enacted by PL 2001,  
4 c. 376, §1, is amended to read:

C. Has a total contract cost, excluding interest and  
operating and maintenance costs, of less than ~~\$1,000,000~~  
8 \$2,000,000 for any school building.
