Presented by Representative PERRY of Calais. Cosponsored by Representatives: EMERY of Cutler, WHEELER of Kittery. 1 **Emergency preamble. Whereas,** acts of the Legislature do not become effective 2 until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the public health and welfare is adversely affected by undetected episodes
of red tide; and

5 **Whereas,** statewide water monitoring efforts need to be improved in anticipation of 6 the spring clamming season; and

7 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within 8 the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as 9 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 10 therefore,

11 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

12 Sec. 1. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

#### 14 MARINE RESOURCES, DEPARTMENT OF

#### 15 Bureau of Resource Management 0027

Initiative: Establishes 4 additional seasonal Conservation Aide Intern positions to be
used for water monitoring purposes. These positions are authorized from April 1, 2006 to
