SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that provisions in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 13157-A requiring landowner permission before operating an ATV on that landowner's property may not be construed to affect the lawful rights of a person holding an easement or right-of-way over the land of another.
