This section may not be construed by a court of law as affirming or not affirming any actions of the Board of Directors of Dirigo Health or the Superintendent of Insurance.'

Further amend the amendment in Part B in section 11 in the first line (page 6, line 36 in amendment) by striking out the following: "November 1," and inserting in its place following: 'November 15,'

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## **SUMMARY**

This amendment strikes the provisions of Committee Amendment "A" to L.D. 1935 that govern the savings offset payment for plan years beginning on or after January 1, 2006 to December 31, 2006 and replaces them with a provision that states that the savings offset payment for plan years beginning January 1, 2006 to December 31, 2006 must equal a total of \$23,000,000 for all health insurance carriers, 3rd-party administrators and employee benefit excess insurance carriers. It specifies that the provision may not be construed by a court of law as affirming or not affirming any actions of the Board of Directors of Dirigo Health or the Superintendent of Insurance. It changes the deadline for the Blue Ribbon Commission on the Long-term Funding of the Dirigo Health Program to report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over insurance and financial services matters and the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over appropriations and financial affairs from November 1, 2006 to November 15, 2006.
