SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 737, L.D. 1936, Bill, "An Act To Include Oral Health Assessment with Other Preschool Testing for Maine's Children"

Amend the amendment in section 4 in the 2nd line (page 4, line 12 in amendment) by striking out the following: "\$150,000" and inserting in its place the following: '\$25,000'

Further amend the amendment in section 5 by striking out the last 4 lines (page 4, lines 29 to 33 in amendment) and inserting in their place the following:
