	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §6451, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1981, c.
4	693, §§5 and 8, is amended to read:
6	1. Student right to screening for sight, hearing, oral
•	health defects. Each student shall must be screened periodically
8	to determine whether they-have the student has sight or hearing defects and must be provided an oral health assessment.

12	693, §§5 and 8, is amended to read:
14	<b>3. Exempt students.</b> A student whose parent objects in writing to screening of <u>on</u> religious grounds shall <u>may</u> not be
