Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows
--

Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2398 is enacted to read:

§2398. License verification

A company that has its main office or headquarters in this State shall obtain from an independent contractor that has a commercial license verification of a valid driver's license and a safe driving record before the company hires the independent contractor to transport the company's merchandise on the State's highways.

This bill requires a company that has its main office or headquarters in the State and that hires an independent contractor to transport the company's merchandise to request from the independent contractor verification of a valid driver's license and a safe driving record before the company hires the independent contractor to transport the company's merchandise on the State's highways.

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
