HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1378, L.D. 1968, Bill, "An Act To Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and To Change Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2006 and June 30, 2007"

Amend the amendment in Part AA in section 1 in the 7th line (page 129, line 28 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Act" and inserting in its place the following: 'Part'

Further amend the amendment in Part AA in section 2 in the 4th line (page 129, line 47 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Part A of this Act" and inserting in its place the following: 'section 3 of this Part'

Further amend the amendment in Part AA by striking out all of section 3 (page 130, lines 1 to 19 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. AA-3. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

12 lines 20 to 23 in amendment) and inserting in its place the
following:

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16 'A. The chief advocate shall report administratively to the
commissioner and advise, consult with and inform the
commissioner on the issues described in this section.'

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20 Further amend the amendment in Part VV in section 4 in
subsection 1 by striking out all of the first paragraph (page
22 157, lines 36 to 48 in amendment) and inserting in its place the
following:

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26 '1. Third priority reserve. The State Controller shall, as
the first 3rd priority after the transfers to the State
Contingent Account pursuant to section 1507 and the transfers to
the Loan Insurance Reserve pursuant to section 1511 at the close
28 of each fiscal year, reserve transfer from the unappropriated
surplus of the General Fund an amount equal to the excess of
30 total--baseline--General--Fund--revenue--received--over--accepted
estimates--in--that--fiscal--year--and--transfer--that--amount--at--the
32 beginning--of--the--next--fiscal--year amount available from the
unappropriated surplus after all required deductions of
34 appropriations, budgeted financial commitments and adjustments
considered necessary by the State Controller have been made as
