2 **Sec. B-1. Existing water commissioners; transition.** The members of the
3 Board of Water Commissioners of the Lisbon Water Department holding office on the
4 effective date of this Act hold office as water commissioners for the terms for which they
5 were elected. The water commissioner whose term expires at the 2006 annual town
6 meeting is eligible for election at the November 2006 municipal election, and that term is
7 extended until June 30, 2007. The water commissioner whose term expires at the 2007
8 annual town meeting is eligible for election at the November 2007 municipal election,
9 and that term is extended until June 30, 2008. The water commissioner whose term
10 expires at the 2008 annual town meeting is eligible for election at the November 2008
11 municipal election, and that term is extended to June 30, 2009.

12 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes
13 effect when approved.

SUMMARY

15 This bill amends the charter of the Lisbon Water Department. It clarifies the terms of
16 the members of the Board of Water Commissioners.
