
HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1382, L.D. 1974, Bill, "An Act To Make Additional Allocations from the Highway Fund and Other Funds for the Expenditures of State Government and To Change Certain Provisions of State Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2005 and June 30, 2006"

Amend the amendment in Part P by striking out all of sections 5 and 6 (page 21, lines 31 to 48 and page 22, lines 1 to 15 in amendment)

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
