HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1382, L.D. 1974, Bill, "An Act To Make Additional Allocations from the Highway Fund and Other Funds for the Expenditures of State Government and To Change Certain Provisions of State Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2005 and June 30, 2006"

Amend the amendment by inserting after Part P the following:

**PART Q**

**Sec. Q-1. 29-A MRSA §460, sub-§2-A is enacted to read:**


2-A. Motorcycle plates: Legislature. In addition to any plate issued pursuant to subsection 1, the Secretary of State, on payment of taxes required in Title 36 and an additional fee to be established by rule, shall issue a specially designed number plate for one designated motorcycle owned or controlled by each member of the Legislature, each representative of an Indian Tribe at the Legislature, the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives. The bureau shall produce those plates within existing budgeted resources. A specially designed motorcycle plate and its registration certificate may be used in place of the regular plate and registration. Rules adopted pursuant to this subsection are routine technical rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.'

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

Minor cost increase - Highway Fund  
Minor revenue increase - Highway Fund

### Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment requires that the Secretary of State must produce and issue specially designed motorcycle registration plates to members of the Legislature within existing budgeted resources. This amendment also authorizes the bureau to establish by rule a fee for these registration plates. There will be minor revenue increase to the Highway Fund as a consequence of these fees.
