SENATE AMENDMENT "F" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1382, L.D. 1974, Bill, "An Act To Make Additional Allocations from the Highway Fund and Other Funds for the Expenditures of State Government and To Change Certain Provisions of State Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2005 and June 30, 2006"

Amend the amendment by adding after Part P the following:

**PART Q**


Sec. Q-1. 29-A MRSA §456-C, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

4. Numbers and letters. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 468, the Secretary of State may issue sportsman registration plates using either numbers or letters or any combination of the 2.'

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment allows the Secretary of State to issue sportsman registration plates using either numbers or letters or any combination of the 2.
