Presented by Representative MARLEY of Portland. (GOVERNOR'S BILL) Cosponsored by Representative: McKENNEY of Cumberland, Senators: DAMON of Hancock, SAVAGE of Knox. **Emergency preamble. Whereas,** Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

8 Whereas, certain obligations and expenses incident to the operation of state departments and institutions will become due 10 and payable immediately; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Sec. D-1. Transfer of Highway Fund unallocated balance; capital program needs; Department of Transportation. Notwithstanding the 4 Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1585 or any other provision of law, at the close of fiscal years 2005-06 and 6 2006-07, the State Controller shall transfer amounts exceeding \$1,000,000 from the unallocated balance in the Highway Fund after 8 the deduction of all allocations, financial commitments, other designated funds or any other transfer authorized by statute and 10 the fiscal year 2005-06 unallocated balance dedicated to the fiscal year 2006-07 budgets to the Department of Transportation 12 for capital needs in the Highway and Bridge Improvement and 14 Maintenance and Operations programs. The Commissioner of Transportation is authorized to allot these funds by financial order upon the recommendation of the State Budget Officer and the 16 approval of the Governor. Within 30 days of approval of the financial order, the Commissioner of Transportation shall provide 18 to the members of the joint standing committee of the Legislature jurisdiction over transportation matters 20 having а report detailing the financial status of the department's capital 22 program.

## PART E

Sec. E-1. Transfer authorized. Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1585 or any other provision of 28 law, for the fiscal years ending June 30, 2006 and June 30, 2007 30 the Commissioner of Transportation is authorized to transfer, by financial order upon the recommendation of the State Budget Officer and approval of the Governor, identified Highway Fund 32 Personal Services savings to any other program or line category 34 within the Highway Fund to fund capital program needs. The financial order must identify the specific savings in Personal Services after assuming all costs for that program including 36 collective bargaining costs. The Commissioner of Transportation 38 shall provide a report by September 15, 2006 and September 15, 2007 to the members of the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over transportation matters 40 detailing the financial adjustments to the Highway Fund.

#### PART F

Sec. **F-1**. Transfer of Personal Services allocations. 46 Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1585 48 or any other provision of law, available balances of Highway Fund allocations for Personal Services in fiscal years 2005-06 and 50 2006-07 may be transferred by financial order between programs and departments

within the Highway Fund upon recommendation of the State Budget
Officer and approval of the Governor to be used for costs associated with collective bargaining agreements for state
employees.

#### PART G

Sec. G-1. Bond Retirement - Highway Fund; lapsed balances.
Notwithstanding any other provision of law, \$2,222 of the unencumbered balance in fiscal year 2004-05 in the Bond
Retirement - Highway Fund account in the Department of Transportation lapses to the unallocated surplus in the Highway
Fund in fiscal year 2005-06.

**Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.

Part B adds the Maine State Law Enforcement Association to 30 the bargaining units authorized to access funding in the Highway Fund Salary Plan account to implement economic terms of 32 collective bargaining agreements for fiscal years ending June 30, 2006 and June 30, 2007.

Part C

Part C limits the state support to the Marine Highway 38 account to 50% of the budgeted revenues that support the operating cost of the Maine State Ferry Service.

Part D

Part D transfers amounts exceeding \$1,000,000 from the unallocated balance in the Highway Fund after the deduction of all allocations, financial commitments, other designated funds or any other transfer authorized by statute to the Department of Transportation for capital needs in the Highway and Bridge Improvement and Maintenance and Operations programs.
