SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1392,
L.D. 1987, Bill, "An Act To Increase Consumer Awareness of Prescription Drug Pricing"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §13797 in the first paragraph in the 2nd line
(page 1, line 16 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "the consumer" the
following: ', on the telephone or in person, depending on the circumstances.'

This amendment clarifies that a pharmacy must give consumer price information in
person or on the telephone.
