1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2501, sub-§1, ¶A,** as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2  
3 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:

4 A. ~~Two-thirds~~ Thirty days of the suspension period has expired; and

6 This bill reduces the waiting period required before a first-time OUI offender  
7 becomes eligible for a work-restricted license to 30 days of the suspension period.
