Resolved: That the Department of Health and Human Services shall amend its rules governing principles of reimbursement for nursing facilities and residential care facilities to rebase the heating costs incorporated in the routine cost component.
21 22 23 24 25	For nursing facilities, the routine cost component base and the related cap that is subject to annual adjustment under the MaineCare principles of reimbursement must be adjusted upward to fully incorporate each facility's actual heating costs incurred during its fiscal year ending in 2005, as long as the adjusted amount is not less than the amount prior to rebasing. All other cost elements must remain the same after rebasing.
26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33 34	For medical and remedial private nonmedical institutions that do not receive MaineCare reimbursement as residential care facilities but instead are reimbursed room and board costs under the section of the department's rules entitled, "Principles of Reimbursement for Residential Care Facilities - Room and Board Costs," the routine cost component base and the related cap of the room and board cost reimbursement must be adjusted upward to fully incorporate each facility's actual heating costs incurred during its fiscal year ending in 2005, as long as the adjusted amount is not less than the amount prior to rebasing.
