Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not 1 2 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 3 Whereas, the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A requires 4 legislative authorization before major substantive agency rules may be finally adopted by 5 the agency; and 6 Whereas, the above-named major substantive rule has been submitted to the Legislature for review; and 7 8 Whereas, immediate enactment of this resolve is necessary to record the 9 Legislature's position on final adoption of the rule; and 10 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as 11 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 12 13 therefore, be it 14 Sec. 1. Adoption. Resolved: That final adoption of Portions of Chapter 113: Regulations Governing the Licensing and Functioning of Assisted Housing Programs -15 Private Non-Medical Institutions Level II, a provisionally adopted major substantive rule 16 of the Department of Health and Human Services that has been submitted to the 17 18 Legislature for review pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, 19 subchapter 2-A, is authorized. Emergency clause.
